

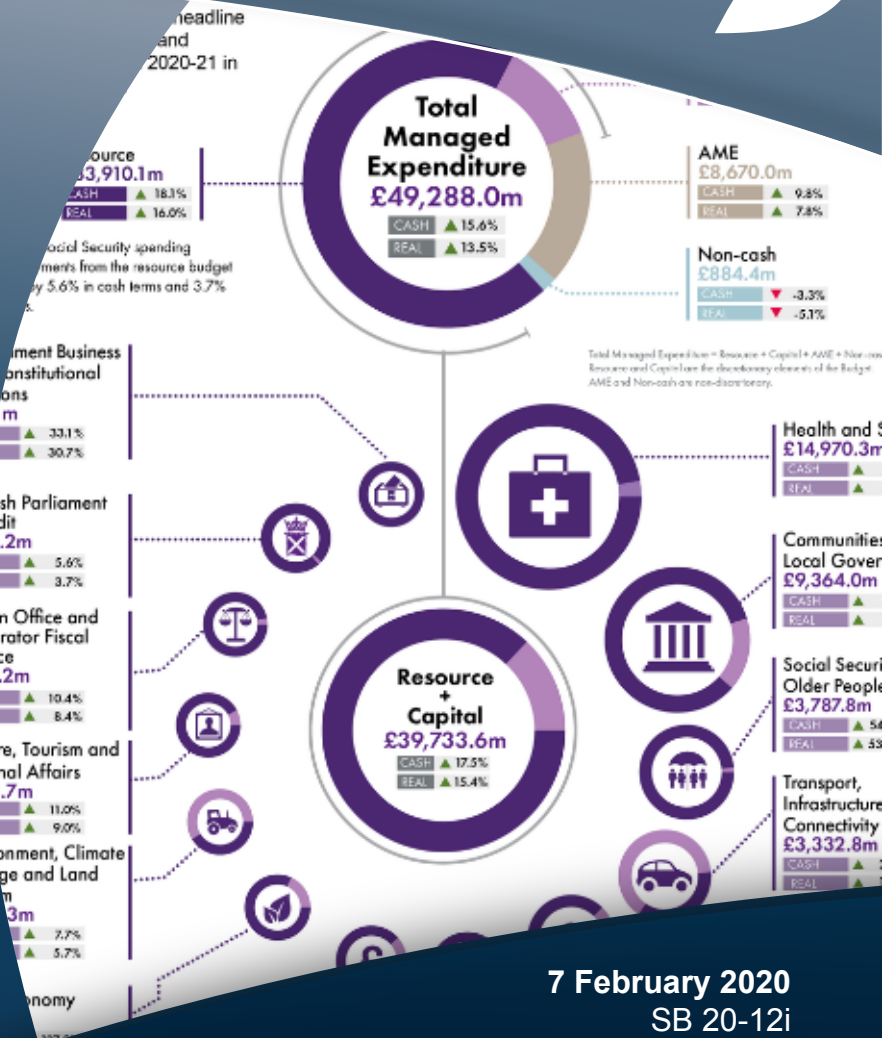

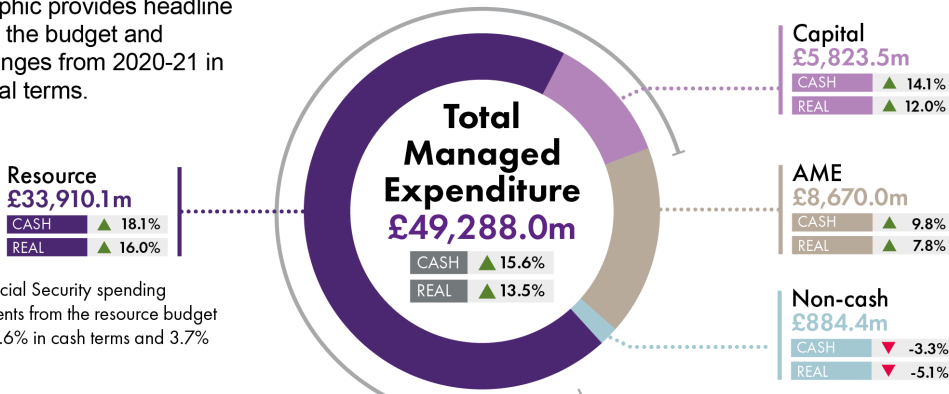

# Scottish Government Budget 2020-21

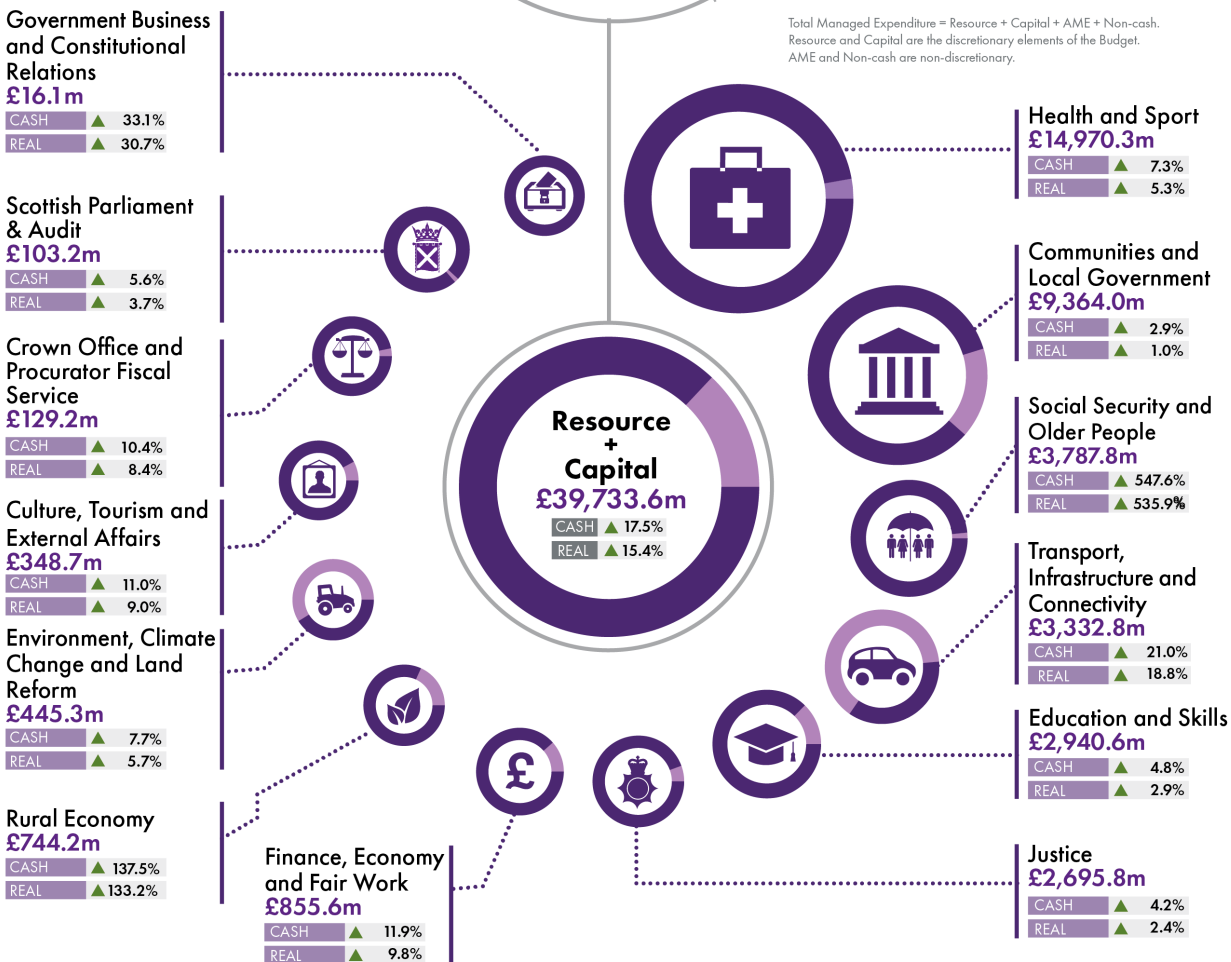

This infographic provides headline figures from the budget and outlines changes from 2020-21 in cash and real terms.



If we remove Social Security spending and Farm Payments from the resource budget it increases by 5.6% in cash terms and 3.7% in real terms.

Total Managed Expenditure = Resource + Capital + AME + Non-cash.  
Resource and Capital are the discretionary elements of the Budget.  
AME and Non-cash are non-discretionary.
